Personal Reflection/Group Discussion

Read <u>Acts 26:9-18</u>.

- 1. What specific things do we learn about Paul in this passage?
- 2. What are specific ways you see God at work in Paul's life?
- 3. How can you tell when God is working in someone's life?
- 4. Has God ever interrupted your life to address a specific issue or to set you in a new direction? If so, what was that experience like?
- 5. How has God been working in your life over the last few weeks? What has He been showing you or saying to you?

Read <u>Luke 10:30-37</u>.

- 6. What happened to the Jewish man in this story (vs. 30)?
- 7. Who came along, and how did they respond (vs. 31-35)?

- 8. What do you think caused the Samaritan to have such compassion?
- 9. How might God's work in your life be beneficial to others too?
- 10. What are simple, practical ways you could join God in His work?
- 11. What's one of the most important Bible verses or truths you learned from this week's teaching?
