Colossians 2:1-10

- 1. What does it look like to be knit together by strong ties of love? (vs. 2)
- 2. Paul warns against being led astray by falsehoods (vs. 4, 8). What are some falsehoods that lead people astray in today's world?
- 3. What does it mean to be complete in Christ? (vs. 10)

LIVE IT

This passage finds Paul encouraging the church at Colossae to continue to follow Jesus. It's not enough to just start, we must persevere (see Luke 8:4-15). Paul's encouragement is to let your roots grow down into Him, and let your lives be built on Him. (vs. 7)
